Directions For Use

- Read the entire label before use.

- Apply only to dry foliage.
- Irrigate after application, especially during periods of high temperatures (28°C or above). Irrigating after application will accelerate initial green-up and will aid in the downward movement of granules into the turf canopy.
- Apply after mowing to prevent particle pick-up by mowing equipment. To further reduce particle pick-up do not collect clippings for one mowing after application.
