Instructions

- READ THE LABEL BEFORE USING.
- Apply when soil temperature is between 12°C and 28°C.

Application Rate

• Mix one part FIESTA with 24 parts water (40 ml in 960 ml of water). Apply the mixed solution at a rate of 200-400 ml/m2. Thoroughly spray weeds -uniform coverage is important. Repeat treatment once in four or more weeks, if necessary. Refer to the product label for complete directions and use restrictions.

Precautions

- KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- CAUTION: CAUSES SLIGHT EYE IRRITATION
- Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, and chewing gum or chewing tobacco.
